STUDIO HANDBOOK



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Thank you for joining my flute studio! The following policies are in place to ensure that students receive my most effective and creative teaching.

MATERIALS AND RESOURCES

Included in your tuition: Studio Classes Recitals Monthly Newsletter RCM and Audition Preparation 50% off student membership with National Flute Association 70% off annual subscription to Sight Reading Factory Student responsibility:

TUITION AND SCHEDULING

Yearly tuition guarantees that I will be present to teach 40 weeks of lessons. For ease and convenience, tuition is divided into twelve equal monthly payments and automatically charged from your card or bank account on the 1st of every month, year-round:

60 minute lessons - \$4,000 yearly | \$333 monthly 45 minute lessons - \$3,400 yearly | \$283 monthly

I handle payment, scheduling and contact information through the Fons app. A nonrefundable registration fee of \$50 per student, or \$75 per family, will be added every September to help offset administrative costs and keep tuition lower. Please note, tuition already accounts for twelve weeks of holidays, school breaks and vacation days. Summer lessons are included in the tuition schedule and are selfscheduled through Fons.



TUITION AND SCHEDULING

MISSED LESSONS

If students must miss a lesson, please cancel on the Fons website with at least 48 hours notice. Please also call, text or email if missing due to a last-minute emergency or illness.

I offer these options to students when they must miss a lesson:

Studio Classes: I teach these biannually at Bethesda Presbyterian as a form of "makeup lesson." They are included in tuition and a great way to receive additional instruction.

Rescheduling: I set aside several hours during select studio breaks for rescheduled lessons. Students may reschedule one lesson each time this is offered. Students/Parents are responsible for scheduling via Fons using the special link shared in monthly newsletters.

Send me a Video: Ahead of their reserved lesson time, students may opt to record themselves playing their assigned material and upload it to our shared google drive. I will use the time to send feedback and answer any questions they have.

Offer Missed Lesson to a Sibling: Do you have another child in the studio? They may receive some additional instruction that week!

Switch to Virtual: Virtual lessons are always an option if students are sick and must stay home but well enough to have a lesson.

I will notify you in advance if I need to cancel a lesson for any reason. If I am sick, I will let you know the morning of the lesson by 9:00AM.

COMMITMENT

To maximize our time together, students will:

- Practice a minimum of 30 minutes per day, 5 days per week.
- Arrive on time, well prepared and with all materials.
- Participate in our studio events, like recitals and studio classes. Optional: Many students enjoy auditioning and performing with school and community ensembles and music camps, as well! They meet other students with similar interests and learn valuable ensemble skills.

COVID-19 POLICIES

TERMINATING LESSONS

30 days written and paid tuition notice is required to stop lessons for any reason. I will prorate the tuition for your final month to reflect the number of lessons you have received based on the last lesson date. Regrettably, I will dismiss a student if any of these circumstances occur:

- Failure to pay tuition on time
- Persistent absences
- Uncooperative attitude
- Failure to follow practice as instructed

During private/group lessons and performances, I ("the teacher") reserve the right to use video recording or take photographs of students for use in lesson demonstration, advertising materials and studio-owned websites.
